BARNSDALE HILL BURLEY BUSHES AND EXTON LANE  
PARISHES OF EXTON BURLEY AND COTTESMORE AND TOWN OF OAKHAM ORDER  
2015**

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

The Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) Barnsdale Hill, Burley Bushes and Exton Lane, Parishes of Exton, Burley and Cottesmore and Town of Oakham Order 2015; as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

PART 1

1. The Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.
2. During the dates and times specified in Part III to this Order all vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of Barnsdale Hill from where it becomes Stamford Road, Burley to its junction with The Avenue Exton, and from proceeding along the length of The Avenue Exton between its junction with Barnsdale Hill and Exton Lane.
3. The duration of the closure shall be as detailed in Part III of this Order
4. The Diversion affects the following streets: The Avenue, Exton (C8324) Cottesmore Road, Exton Road Cottesmore, Toll Bar, (B668), Hall Close, Main Street and Burley Road, Cottesmore, Cottesmore Road and Oakham Road, Burley, Burley Road, Burley Park Way, Oakham (A606), Stamford Road Roundabout (A606), and Stamford Road (A606) with a reciprocal route.

PART II

This order shall be cited as Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary diversion of vehicular traffic) Barnsdale Hill, Burley bushes and Exton lane, Parishes of Exton Burley and Cottesmore and Town of Oakham order 2015.
