Notice of Application to Designate a Ketton and Tinwell Neighbourhood Area

An application has been made to Rutland County Council under Regulation 5 of the above-mentioned Regulations for designation of a Ketton and Tinwell Neighbourhood Area. The application relates to the whole area of the Ketton and Tinwell Parishes. It includes:

- a statement why the area is appropriate to be designated as a neighbourhood area;
- a statement explaining that the body making this area application is capable of being a “qualifying body”;
- a map showing the proposed neighbourhood area.
