



Social Car Scheme

Voluntary Action Rutland operates an extensive transport scheme (a door-to-door service) for frail, elderly, disabled and vulnerable people in Rutland who have difficulty in travelling independently around the area covered by the Social Car Scheme.

Volunteer Drivers use their own vehicles to pick up clients and return them to their own address, The drivers will wait for a reasonable time whilst the appointment or visit is taking place.

Clients who travel with our transport scheme are expected to contribute toward the cost of the journey to a set tariff.
