**(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE)**  
**NORTH LUFFENHAM LEVEL CROSSING, STATION ROAD**  
**PARISH OF NORTH LUFFENHAM CP ORDER 2018**

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) Station Road, Parish of North Luffenham CP Order 2018, as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below all vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of road known as North Luffenham Level Crossing, Station Road from Ketton Road to Stamford Road (A6121).

The duration of the Closure shall be for a maximum period of six months from 13th October 2018 or until the works are completed.

The closure is to enable Network Rail, undertake works on the crossing.

It is anticipated the works will take 2 days. The closure shall come into force when the appropriate signs and diversion route are erected on site.

The duration of the Closure shall be as follows: from 22:00 hours on 13th October 2018 until 09:00 on 14th October 2018

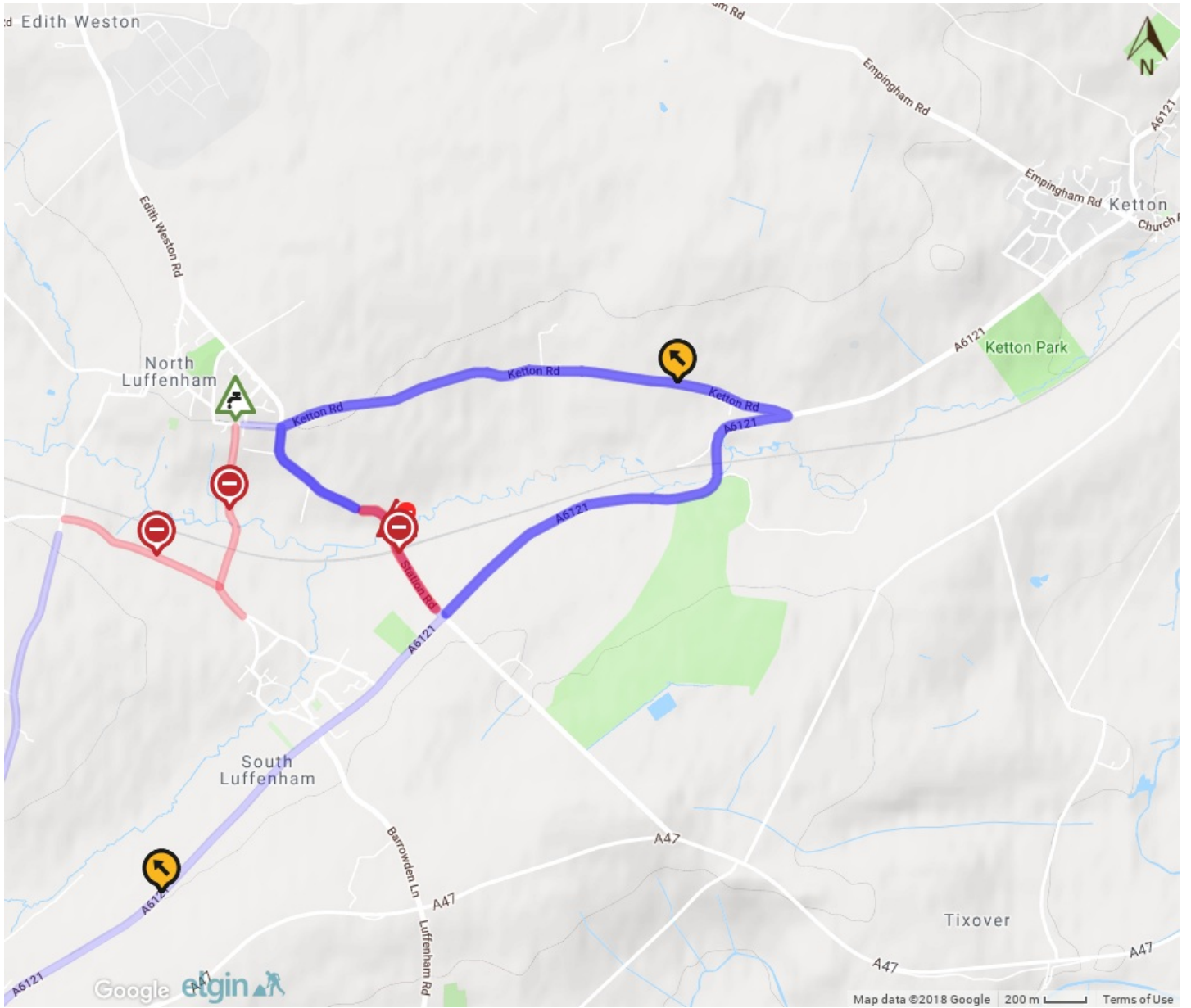
The alternative route during the closure will be via the route shown on the attached plan (also available to view at the Council Office) and/or as shown on roadworks.org

The alternative route during the closure will be via the following streets: Station Road, Ketton Road, Foster's Bridge and Stamford Road (A6121) with a reciprocal route.

There will be no emergency or pedestrian access over the level crossing while the work is being carried out.
