- Pass a copy of the completed Order Form to the Resilience Officer for your district, borough or ward. They will sign the form and submit it for processing

If you intend to request an item that does not appear on the order form:

- Complete the back page of the Order Form and post or email it (back page only) to the LLR Prepared office, including contact details for the reply
- On receipt of the relevant price information from the team, complete the Order Form with items to a maximum total value of £600 by entering the order quantities against the relevant items and details of the quoted for items on the back page
- Complete page 2 with the contact details of those people we should contact in an emergency and in relation to this order
- Pass a copy of the completed Order Form to the Resilience Officer for your district, borough or ward. They will sign the form and submit it for processing
