(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE)
North Luffenham Road
Parish of Morcott Order 2020**

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) North Luffenham Road Parish of Morcott Order 2020 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because of the measures in place for the CA Waste site.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below all vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding Northbound along the length of road known as North Luffenham Road from Willoughby Road to Glebe Road

The duration of the closure and one-way system shall be for a maximum period of twelve months from 19th November 2020 or until the works for the new entrance at the Waste site are completed.

The closure and one-way system are scheduled to be in place for 365 days. The closure and one-way system shall come into force when the appropriate signs and diversion route are erected on site.

The duration of the Closure and One-way System shall be as follows: from 19th November 2020 to the completion of the new Waste site entrance.

The alternative route during the closure will be via the route shown on the attached plan and as shown on <https://one.network>

The alternative route during the closure will be via the following streets: Willoughby Road, High Street, Stamford Road, Back Lane, North Luffenham Road and Pilton Road

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
