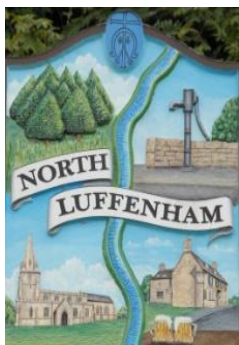


North Luffenham Parish Council



Minutes of a Parish Council Extraordinary Meeting held on
Thursday 28th October at 7.30 pm
at North Luffenham Community Centre

**Present: Cllr's Smith, Sewell, Canham, Cade, Anker, Barsby
and Marsh.**

There were 10 members of the Public in attendance

- 153/21** Apologies received from Cllrs Burrows, Canham & Co. Cllrs Waller and Bool Bool.
- 154/21** No Interests declared
- 155/21** To approve Parish Council land to be designated as Local Green Spaces.
Cllr Smith recapped and explained that only a Parish Council (PC) can enact a Neighbourhood Plan (NP): so the policies of the NP are those of the NLPC

The policies have been circulated, and the main issue for the meeting was for Parish land to be designated as Local Green Spaces (LGS)
By designating it as LGS it effectively becomes similar to Green Belt.

Definition of Parish Council Land:

LGS 5 - The Field Garden, Woodland Walk and Allotments

LGS 6 - The Oval

Cllr Smith advised that if the if the NP is approved this will also apply to the other LGS described:

LGS 1 - Field 1 from the churchyard stile to the River Chater

LGS 2 - Field 2 from River Chater, uphill, towards the railway line and Glebe Road.

LGS 3 & LGS 4 - Fields 3 and 4 from Moor Lane, near the River Chater, uphill, towards the village towards Digby Drive.

LGS 7 - Butt Lane from the junction of Edith Weston Road, and the section of Land, up to the parish boundary.

LGS 8 - The Water Gardens.

If the PC approves the designation and the other policies it is not the final say as the policies when finally completed will go to the parish for consultation and comment:

- Distributed to the parish.
- Posted on the website.
- An exhibition in the Community Centre

Parishioners will be invited to make comments and these will be taken into consideration and then submitted as a REG 14 document to RCC.

It has to go through a number of statutory processes and be approved by an external examiner.

When this approval has been given, it can be voted on by the parish, in a referendum

Agenda item 155/21 was approved: 3 were in favour, and 2 against.

156/21 To note the Policies from NP Steering Group:
The policies of the NP, previously circulated, were noted and discussed.

157/21 Agreement was made with regard to the Bonfire night to include writing to the Oval Recreation committee to hold the event on the 5th November, review the areas of responsibility and the actions needed and endorse the proposals contained in the Administrative Instructions.
