EMERGENCY ROAD CLOSURE AT Edith Weston Road, North Luffenham

UNDER S 14(2) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers contained in s14(2) Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has issued this notice in relation to surfacing works following a lorry fire because of the likelihood of danger to the public

The effect of the notice is that Edith Weston Road shall be closed with immediate effect.

The maximum duration of this notice shall be 21 days from the date below.

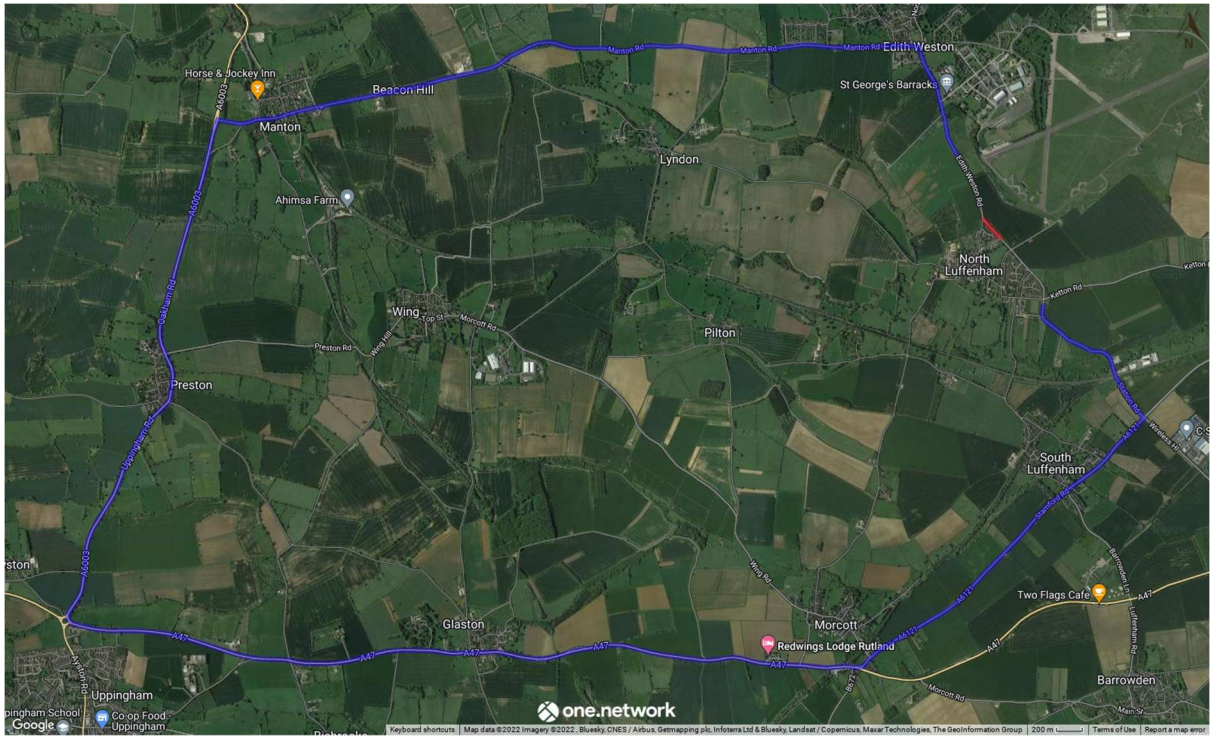
During the implementation of this notice the diversion route shall be via Edith Weston Road, North Luffenham Road, Manton Road, Lyndon Road, Uppingham Road, Oakham Road, Uppingham Roundabout, Duddington Way, Main Road, Morcott Road, Glaston Road, Stamford Road and Station Road with a reciprocal route.
